SUMMER SCHOOL 2016

Masconomet will offer summer school courses for remediation and enrichment during July and August. The remedial courses will enable students to make up courses failed during the regular academic year. Both programs are described in detail below.

Remedial Programs:

Any student who has failed either or both semesters of one or more of the following required courses should select the appropriate summer school option. Mastery of the objectives of these courses is required before the student will be allowed to continue in the required sequence of courses in that department. Permission to pursue a remedial option other than the Masconomet Summer School must be obtained in writing from the Senior High School Principal <u>prior</u> to the end of June. Some students who have failed due to chronic truancy or other attendance problems may be required to repeat the course rather than attend summer school.

English 9	English 9, Semester I and/or II
English 10	English 10, Semester I and/or II
English 11	English 11, Semester I and/or II
English 12	English 12, Semester I and/or II
World History 2	World History 2, Semester I and/or II
American History 1	American History 1, Semester I and/or II
American History 2	American History 2, Semester I and/or II
Algebra 1	Algebra 1, Semester I and/or II
Algebra 2	Algebra 2, Semester I and/or II
Geometry	Geometry, Semester I and/or II
Spanish	Spanish 1,2, 3 Semester I and/or II

Students going from Grade 8 to Grade 9, who are recommended for summer school, have two options:

- Those scheduled to take Algebra I (cont) in Grade 9 should take the three-week program in Basic Math Skills;
- Those scheduled to take Geometry in Grade 9 should take the six-week course in Algebra I.

Courses will be offered in ****two-and-half-hour blocks (2.5 hr)**** at the times listed below and will meet ****Monday through Thursday****. Parents must arrange their vacation plans around summer school if their child is to be successful.

Students may <u>not</u> take vacation during summer school.

-A student may enroll in a maximum of two summer school courses.

-The tuition is \$385 for per course.

-Courses are scheduled to run for 6 weeks.

-Summer school begins on July 5 and ends on August 11.

-All students attending a remedial summer school course should report at 8:00 am on Tuesday July 5.

-Students will be notified before they leave school that day as to their schedule for the rest of the summer.

Remedial Summer School Class Schedule

8:00-10:30	1 st Block
10:30-10:45	Break
10:45-1:15	2 nd Block

Students are scheduled according to the following priorities:

- Students who need to take two classes are able to do so
- Class size is balanced as much as possible so that each student's needs can be met
- Student preference as to class time

To receive credit for a summer school course, the student must demonstrate mastery of the material. The student will be given the opportunity to demonstrate mastery any time after Thursday, July 21 (three weeks into the program) if he/she has been present in 85% or more of the class sessions and has completed all work to the satisfaction of the teacher. <u>Most students will need to remain the entire six weeks to complete requirements of the courses</u>. A student whose attendance level is below 85% on Thursday, August 11, will not receive credit for summer school.

Grades received in the remedial summer school will appear on the student's transcript as Pass or Fail and will not be used in the calculation of his/her grade point average. The student's original grade will also appear on the transcript.

Registration for summer school should be completed by 3 pm on Thursday June 30thth although late registrations will be accepted.

Full payment of tuition must be included with the registration form.

Registration forms will be available after June 1st in the Guidance Office, Senior High School Principal's Office and on the Masconomet web page.

Enrichment Programs:

Connections in Mathematics:

Students who score below 240 on the grade 8 MCAS mathematics test are required to take this course in preparation for the grade 10 MCAS mathematics test. This requirement may be met as a 3 week summer course or as a semester course during the school year. Students choosing to meet the requirement during the summer may select the session and time they will attend. The options are listed below. For Summer 2015 this program is funded through a grant from the Massachusetts Department of Elementary and Secondary Education so the \$195 tuition is waived.
