## **Core Responsibilities:**

#### **Personnel Supervision and Evaluation**

- Collaborates with Director of Teaching and Learning and Principals to observe and evaluate science teachers
- Mentors new and leave replacement teachers
- Recommends hiring/retention based on performance and student data
- Provides model lessons and targeted instructional coaching

## **Curriculum Leadership**

- Oversees curriculum design, revision, and assessment for grades 7–12
- Supports teachers in leveraging technology integration to enhance science teaching and student engagement, including simulations and data analysis tools
- Coordinates department meetings and pilot programs
- Leads communication across buildings to ensure alignment
- Provides leadership in curriculum evaluation and adoption

## **Teaching**

- Maintains a teaching load as per contract (ensuring credibility and firsthand insight into classroom realities)
- Complete all tasks associated with teaching science

## **Budget and Resources**

- Prepares and monitors science department budgets
- Maintains supply inventories and coordinates material replacement
