- **A.** <u>Call to Order</u> T. Cooper, Chair, called the regular meeting of the School Committee of June 10, 2020 to order at 7:03 p.m. via zoom teleconference.
- **B.** Remarks from Chair T. Cooper reviewed the zoom teleconference meeting guidelines. T. Cooper made a statement regarding George Floyd.

- **D.** Coronavirus Response Update M. Harvey informed the SC that he has received the initial guidance for summer programming and the supplies needed for September re-opening. There are a number of re-opening scenarios, from fully open to all remote and somewhere in between. All districts will be using the same mandated model. M. Harvey reviewed the discussion with a meeting with Senator Tarr which included the state financial outlook for FY21 and level funding. Summer school re-opening guidance was reviewed and all summer programs will be remote. The key safety supplies to re-open were discussed and a 12 weeks supply of all PPEs is recommended. M. Harvey read the statement of the Commissioner for what re-opening would look like.
- E. Middle School Principal Report J. Dillon provided the SC with an update. Course registration is done; 6th grade transitions completed and virtual assemblies were held. The guidance department ran the virtual assembly for over 600 attendees. Student council visits were done virtually as well. IEP co-ordination was completed with Patty for transitioning 6th graders. The elementary school principals will submit any gaps from remote learning for the incoming 6th graders. The portfolio projects are on track for the entire 8th grade beginning in the fall. The Welcome to Masco video used for parent night was very successful and may be used moving forward. Student Council elections were done virtually. Olivia Gatti, the librarian is running a virtual book club for the students. The Pen Pal Program with students from Senegal is continuing. The 9th grade French students will receive the letters in the fall. J. Dillon praised the IT Department for their tireless work getting the teachers up to speed with remote learning. The teachers have evolved and the lessons are meeting standards and expectations of Masco. Book drop off and student belongings pickup will be done this week and the yearbooks have arrived. Monday will be the virtual

promotion ceremony which will include a 4 minute clip of the school play.
