The Junior Prom Committee is excited to announce the 2019 Junior Prom at Blue Ocean Music Hall on **Friday May 10th**, 2019. Please read the following important details regarding the evening.

Ticket sales:

- Tickets will be on sale for two weeks: **Monday April 1st through Friday April 12th** during B lunch. You may also see Mrs. Brouillard in Room H2020 before or after school if there are any issues. **This is a hard deadline**. **Purchase your ticket early**. **No tickets will be sold after Friday**, **April 12th!**
- **Tickets cost \$95**. Cash or check only. Checks should be made out to "Masconomet Class of 2020" and should include the student's name in the memo section.
- · Tickets will only be sold to Masconomet juniors.
- Masconomet juniors who wish to purchase a ticket for a date to the prom must complete the permission form, which can be found in the House D office. These forms must be completed with valid photo identification and be approved by Vice Principal DiNardo prior to purchasing tickets. Please be aware, dates include Masconomet students who are not juniors. NO tickets will be sold to non-Masconomet juniors without this approved form.

 - Domestic Cheese Board: Assorted Artisanal Cheeses, Fresh Grapes, Crisp Crackers

 - Dessert: Freshly Baked Cookies & Whoopie Pies
- · Students should inform ticket sales associates or Mrs. Brouillard about their own or their date's dietary restrictions.

Table reservations

· Only students who purchased a ticket can sign up for a seat at a table – holding seats for friends or changing your seats will not be permitted.

Special Notes

- Students who arrive late (after 7pm) will not be admitted to the event. Please consider Friday evening traffic in the area in order to arrive on time.
- · All students will have a breathalyzer test administered to them by school administration upon entry. Students are also subject to testing at any time during the event.
- · Masconomet is not providing transportation to or from Blue Ocean Music Hall. Students should carpool or arrange to be dropped off/picked up at the venue.
- Students/guests who leave the Prom before the designated end time will not be readmitted.
- · All bags/purses are subject to search; students do NOT need to bring any money with them.
- · If you need to take any medication to the prom, you should see Mrs. Brouillard or Ms. DiNardo to get it cleared prior to the event.
- Reminder that there is no nurse available during the prom, so no Ibuprofen or acetaminophen will be available. Students are allowed to carry their own inhalers and Epinephrine auto-injectors and are strongly encouraged to do so. Chaperones trained in Epinephrine administration will be available during the event. Please contact the nurse if you have any specific concerns regarding your or your child's medical issues.
